- PASS 8 REQUIRED COURSES (32 CREDIT HOURS)
- PASS 10 ELECTIVES (40 CREDIT HOURS)
- TOTAL OF 18 COURSES (72 CREDIT HOURS)
 - 5 COURSES (INCL. ENGLISH) AT GRADE 12 LEVEL
 - MUST BE ENROLLED FULL TIME IN GRADES 11&12
 - MUST ATTEMPT 21 COURSES (84 CREDIT HOURS)
 - SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETE THE ELPA

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Required Courses:

- English 11 Informational Text
- English 11 Literary Text
- 2 Math courses from (NRF 10, Foundations 110, Fin & Workplace 110, Fin and Workplace 120 or NBCC Skilled Trades Math 120 – only in grade 12)
- Science course
- Humanities course
- Fine Arts & Life Development course
- English 12

Total: 8 courses = 32 credit hours

ELPA must be passed; re-writes in gr. 11

COMPETITIVE & APPLICATION COURSES
